GO Wales: Achieve through Work Experience

Here are examples of the documents that you could provide to evidence you meet the eligibility criteria for the Programme:

Your legal right to live in the UK during the period of ESF support

- Plastic card or letter from HMRC showing your National Insurance number
- Correspondence confirming receipt or award of loans / grants provided via Student Finance Wales / Student Loans Company
- Birth / adoption certificate (EU Member State)
- Letter from the UK Immigration and Nationality Directorate
- Residency permits for foreign nationals (usually in passport)

Your age

- Birth certificate
- Driving licence, full or provisional (EU)
- Passport, expired or unexpired
- National Identity Card (EU)
- Northern Ireland Voters Card

In full time education

- Evidence of enrolment / registration at university / college (documentation or a referral / introduction from the institution)
- Correspondence to confirm receipt of grants / financial awards e.g. Student Finance Wales

Care leaver

- Letter from Local Authority (social worker, personal adviser, social work department, home manager)
- Letter from supporting organisation (e.g. Barnardo's, Foyer Federation)
- Letter on company headed paper from a professional person (doctor, lawyer, teacher, counsellor, student adviser)
- Care Plan

From a low HE participation neighbourhood – evidence of home address

- Driving licence, full or provisional (EU)
- Recent (within 3 months) statement from bank / building society / credit card company / credit union
- Recent (within 3 months) utility bill or council tax demand / correspondence
- Rent card / statement
- Tenancy agreement / documents
- Evidence of registration on electoral roll
- HMRC correspondence
